



Item Pricing Grid (Pro 5, 6, 6.5, 7.x VFP, 7.x SQL)



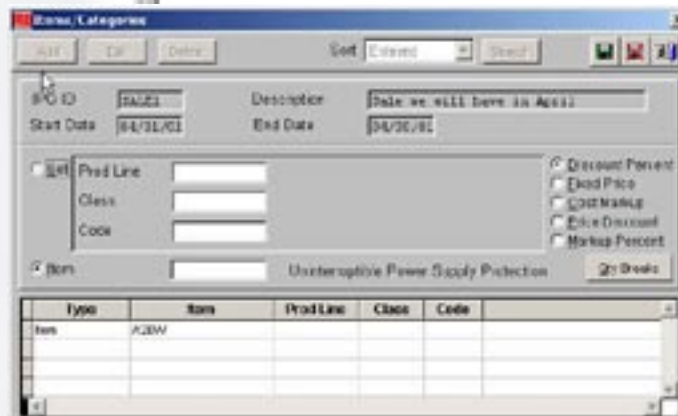
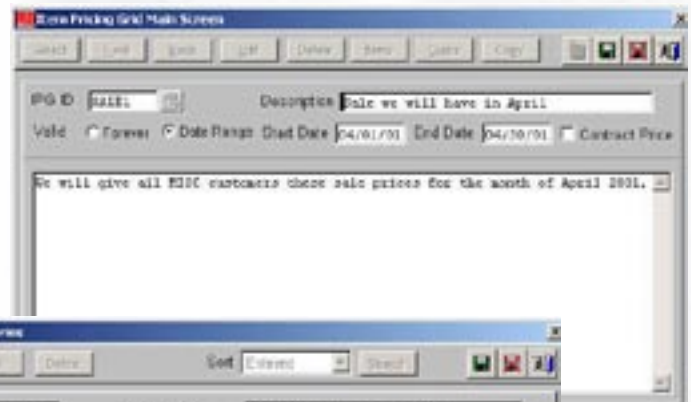
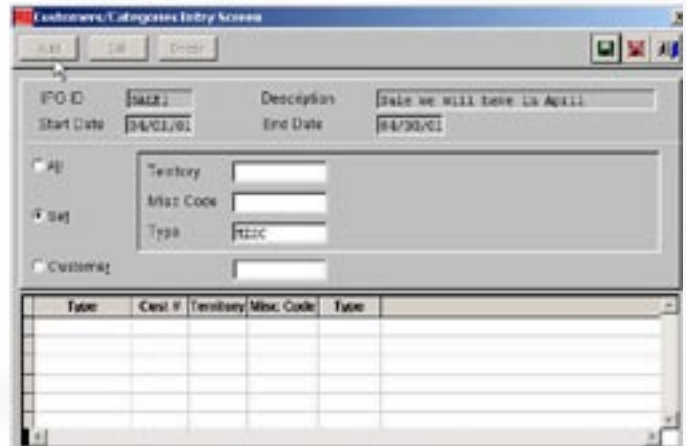
The Item Pricing Grid (IPG) was developed for the user who has attempted to implement the Pro Series pricing scheme only to find it confusing and difficult to set up. It is flexible in both the Customer and Item setup process. IPG also now supports Customer Contract Pricing.

Features

- Works with or without using Pro Series' current pricing schemes.
- Has all of the pricing options available in Pro Series: Discount Percent, Fixed Price, Cost Markup, Price Discount and Markup Percent along with 6 quantity levels.
- Uses flexible pricing "groups."
- Set up groups to be valid forever, or for a date range. Excellent for setting up sale pricing.
- Ability to specify that a price group belongs to all customers, a set of customers or specific customers
- A set of customers can be defined by any combination of Territory, Misc. Code and Type—all from the customer master screen.
- Assign items or groups of items based on combinations of Product Line, Class and Code.
- Great for sale pricing, contract pricing, and for people who are tired of trying to deal with Pro Series' pricing scheme.
- Copy a price group that you have set up to a new price group.

New Feature

Contract Pricing: If you select this option, it will give the customer that price regardless of any other prices in the system. This is extremely important in industries where prices are changing frequently and a negotiated price is set up for a specified period of time (using the date range functionality). Contract pricing is set up by price grid so all items associated in that contract are included.



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
